

Supporting children with a hearing loss

An online course based on best practice for Teachers/ EY practitioners who are supporting pupils with a hearing loss in EY settings and schools. The course also includes a half day's initial group training with a further half day during the course.

This is an opportunity for your Nursery/ educational setting to develop understanding and ensure your staff have the knowledge and skills required to meet the needs of this low incidence group of children

Who is the course for?

Any Teacher/ EY's practitioner working with, or with an interest in working with, children with a hearing loss.

The activities throughout the course relate directly to the practitioner's role, so involvement with a child with a hearing loss is useful to be able to fully participate in the course.

What does the course cover?

The **online training course (OLT)** consists of materials which are designed to actively involve the participant in their learning, to consider best practice and relate it directly to their current work, focusing on:

- the impact of a hearing loss on development
- technology used with pupils
- hearing loss and additional needs,
- why assessment is important and the information it can provide
- strategies for including pupils with a hearing loss

What are the benefits of the course?

- learn at your own pace with access to up-to-date materials and videos
- engage in a range of practical, theoretical and reflective activities
- opportunities to contribute to discussions with other professionals in online forums
- view real case studies across all ages and settings,
- join face to face sessions arranged with your tutor (a Qualified Teacher of the Deaf)
- set goals and interventions to transfer your learning to the classroom
- CPD and Natsip certificate on completion

How long is the course?

The course begins with an introductory afternoon on **Tuesday 28th January 2020 1.30-3pm**.

There will be a half day afternoon practical session **Tuesday 17th March 2020**

Completion of online course, goals setting and 90 days work place interventions by **9th July 2020**.

Training will be held at **Elmfield House, Westbury-on-Trym, BS10 6AY**
